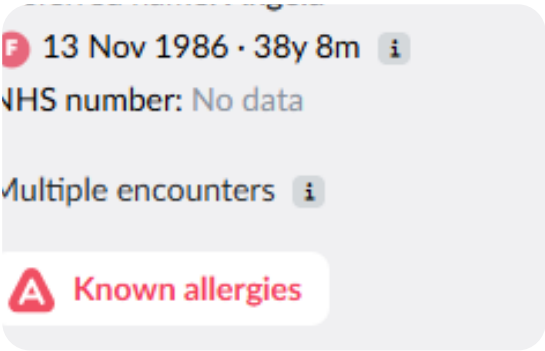

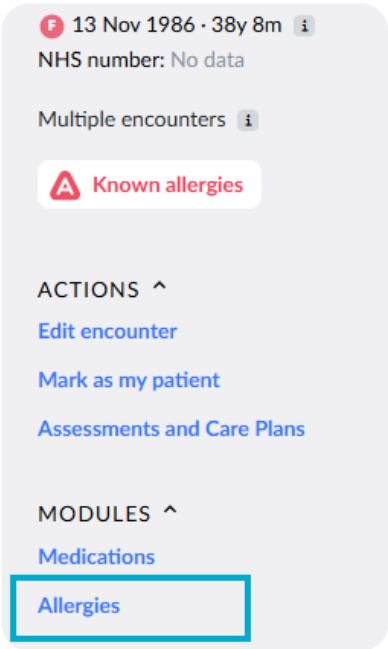

When a patient is selected and the Patient screen appears, it can clearly be seen what the patient's allergy status is. Here, as seen in red, the patient has Known allergies

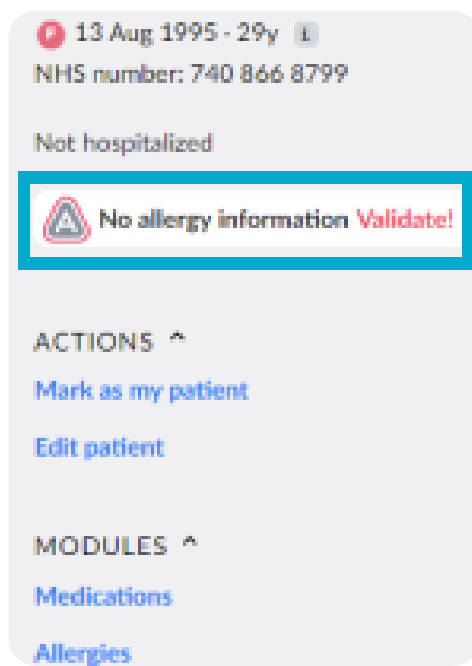


Clicking the red warning, will show some details of the allergy in a pop out box. However, clicking on the 'Allergies Module' will show full details of the allergies, in addition to any recorded comments.

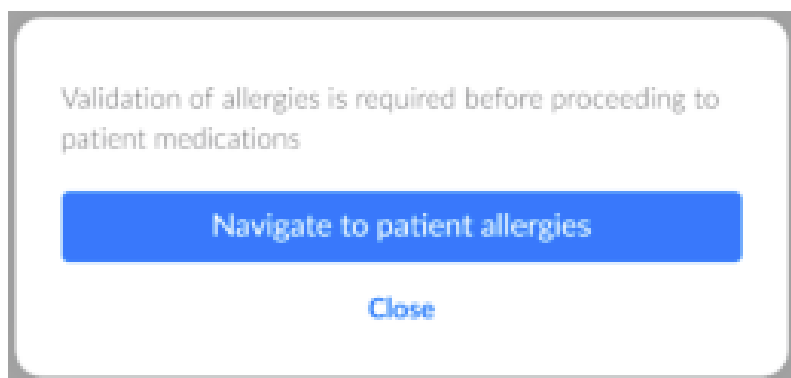


If the patient has No allergy information recorded, then you are warned to Validate!

The patient's allergy status must be validated, before you are allowed access to the Medications Module.



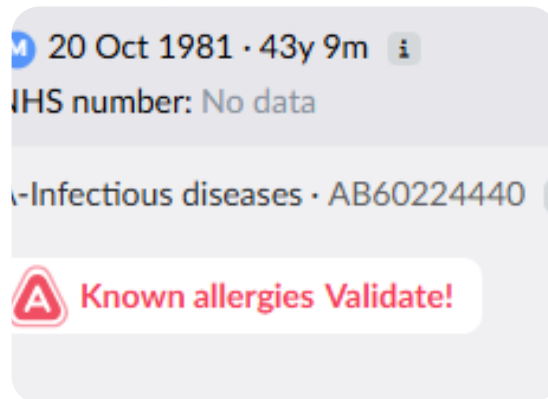
Attempts to access the Medications Module without validating the patient's allergies, will receive this warning:



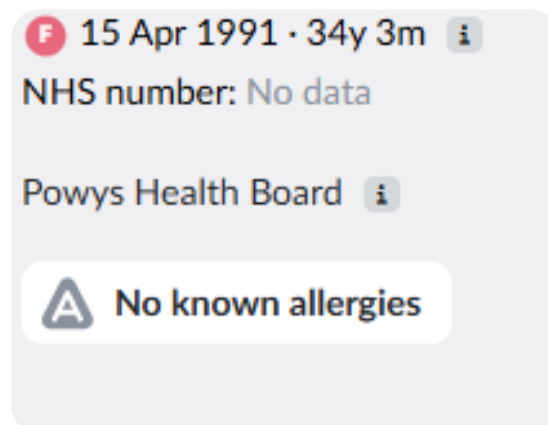
Clicking the Navigate to patient allergies blue bar will take you to the Allergies Module, where you can add and edit allergy information.

Alternatively, you could access the Patient's Allergies Module complete allergy status (see page 2 above for how to access the module)

Other warnings may appear, when a patient has a known allergy, but the record requires validation



Once a Patient's allergy status is validated as 'No known allergies, this will also appear in the patient record (as below).
